Subject: District Conflict of Interest Code Amendment

BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S BRIEFING PAPER

ISSUE:

The District's Conflict of Interest Code is due for the biennial review as requested by Fresno County.

BACKGROUND:

The District's Conflict of Interest Code was last updated and approved by the Fresno County Board of Supervisors in 2018. Fresno County requests biennial reviews of conflict of interests codes for all special districts.

DISCUSSION:

The District's Conflict of Interest Code is reviewed and approved by the Fresno County Board of Supervisors biennially on even years. Staff reviewed the District's Conflict of Interest Code and determined the Code needed to be updated to reflect the current positions and titles within the District.

ALTERNATIVES:

There are no alternatives to present. The Conflict of Interest Code is required by the Political Reform Act (GC Sec. 81000, et seq.).
