BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S BRIEFING PAPER

ISSUE:

The next cycle of the Volunteer Fire Assistance (VFA) Grant is open for applications. Grant applications must be submitted no later than May 11, 2018.

BACKGROUND:

The District has received the grant in the past and used the funds to purchase Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

DISCUSSION:

This grant is a 50% reimbursement grant. The total of the grant is approximately \$40,000. Total reimbursement back to the District will be 50% of what was actually spent or approximately \$20,000. District staff would like to purchase structural PPE with this grant.

ALTERNATIVES:

1. The District could decide to not apply for the grant.

IMPACTS (Consider potential consequences related to each of the following areas of concern for proposed alternatives):

- Fiscal – Staff can add the VFA Grant to the FY 18/19 budget. The District would be reimbursed up to 50% of what is actually spent or approximately \$20,000.00.
- Operational – The PPE is needed to maintain serviceable PPE for operational personnel.

- Interagency – No known impact.


RECOMMENDATION:
