# **BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S BRIEFING PAPER**

## ISSUE:

Staff has finalized the draft 2020-2025 Mobile Equipment Replacement Plan (MERP) for Board consideration and discussion.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The District updates and develops a comprehensive MERP every five years to serve as a roadmap for current and future fleet needs.

### **DISCUSSION:**

Staff has been working diligently since last fall summarizing current fleet status and researching/developing future fleet strategies to maximize the District's return on fleet investments. This updated plan focusses on maintaining fleet vitality while pursuing economical and operational goals within historic budgetary constraints. In addition, this plan explores implementing fleet concepts that will position the District well for successful navigation during current/expected economic and industry turbulence due to the Covid pandemic. It is expected that staff will present the final MERP plan at the regularly scheduled September 2020 District Board Meeting.
