## Kitchen Hood System Requirements (UL 300 System)

Kitchen Hood and exhaust cleaned? Mesh Filters are not allowed
Hood Extinguishing system serviced & tagged in the last six (6) months? Last date serviced
Class "K" extinguisher serviced, tagged & mounted within 30 feet of the hood assembly?
Cafeteria personnel trained in the use of the extinguishers?
Exiting Requirements
Exits are unobstructed and open-able?
The common path of egress travel does not exceed 75 feet?
For occupancy loads of 50 or more, every building has at least two or more exits?
Do rooms used for assembly purpose have the occupant load posted near the main exit?
Are exit doors open-able from the inside without the use of a key?
Do egress doors in the classroom swing in the direction of egress travel if occupant load is 50 or more?
The Means of egress, including the exit discharge, shall be illuminated at all times while the building space served by the means of egress is occupied?
Housekeeping Requirements
Every building (classroom) is maintained in a neat and orderly manner, preventing any condition that would create fire or life hazard?
Child-prepared artwork and teaching materials do not exceed 50% of the wall area?
Storage of combustible materials are separated from any heating devices?
All combustible waste containers larger than 40 gallons are constructed of approved noncombustible or approved combustible material with lid?
All combustible waste containers larger than 1.5 cubic yards are not stored in Buildings or places within 5ft of combustible walls, openings or roof eave lines?

All material susceptible to spontaneous ignition, such as oily rags, are stored in a listed disposal container?
Heater and boiler room clear of all storage?
Janitor's storage area free of any flammable liquids?
Electrical Requirements
Electrical enclosures or panels have a minimum 36 inch width, and 78 inch height clear access and work space maintained?
A sign stating ELECTRICAL ROOM (or similar wording) is plainly visible on the doors going into the electrical control panel room?
The switch board or panel board is legibly and durably marked indicating its purpose in case service is disconnected?
Extension cords are not being used as a substitute for permanent wiring?
Cords maintained in good condition without splices, deterioration or damage?
The amp capacity of the extension cord is not less than the rated capacity of the portable appliance supplied by the cord?
