POLICY NO.: 1590

SUBJECT: Uniform and Protective Clothing-Schedule C Employees

EFFECTIVE DATE: June 1, 2014

RESPONSIBILITY: Fresno County Fire Protection District

POLICY:

- A) The cost of uniforms and/or protective clothing, shoes, etc., that employees are required to wear shall be borne by the District.
- B) The only Schedule C employees who are required to wear a particular uniform and/or protective clothing while on duty are the following:
 - Senior Fire Inspector
 - Fire Inspector
 - Shop Mechanic
- C) The District has the option of authorizing reimbursements to qualifying employees upon proof of purchase; arranging with local retailers to supply all qualifying employees with a specific product that meets the needs and/or safety requirements; or by providing to each designated employee above a Uniform Allowance of \$700.00 every 12 months.

POLICY RESPONSIBILITY:

Board of Directors, Fire Chief, District Administrative Officer, Division Chiefs, Battalion Chiefs.
