## BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S BRIEFING PAPER

### ISSUE:

The District's Conflict of Interest Code has been updated and amended to reflect the current format requested by Fresno County.

### BACKGROUND:

The District's Conflict of Interest Code was last updated and approved by the Fresno County Board of supervisors in August of 2016.

### DISCUSSION:

The District's Conflict of Interest Code is reviewed and approved by the Fresno County Board of Supervisors biennially on even years. Staff reviewed the District's Conflict of Interest Code and determined the Code needed to be updated to follow the format requested by Fresno County.

### ALTERNATIVES:

There are no alternatives to present. The Conflict of Interest Code is required by the Political Reform Act (GC Sec. 81000, et seq.).
